## 1. CALL TO ORDER

Chairwoman Simon called the meeting to order at 3:01 p.m.

#### 2. ROLL CALL

Ms. Simon asked Deputy Clerk Carter to call the roll. Committee members Simon, Schron and Stephens were in attendance and a quorum was determined. Committee member Brown was in attendance shortly after the roll-call was taken. Committee member Jones was absent from the meeting. Councilmember Miller was also in attendance.

Children Program for the period 1/1/2020 – 12/31/2020 to extend the time period to 12/31/2021 and for additional funds in the amount not-to-exceed \$1,433,551.00; authorizing the County Executive to execute the amendment and all other documents consistent with this Resolution; and declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective.

Dr. Rebekah Dorman, Director of the Office of Early Childhood Invest in Children; Ms. Zeppora McClain, Systems Manager for Starting Point; Mr. Daniel Moss, UPK Program Manager; and Ms. Debbie Fodge, Interim Executive Director of Starting Point, addressed the Committee regarding Resolution No. R2021-0030. Discussion ensued.

WHEREAS, the County Executive/ Department of Public Works/County Engineer has recommended an amendment to Contract No. 78 with United Labor Agency Incorporated for operation of the Workforce Service Center, job seekers and employer services and management of the On-the-Job Training Program for the period 7/1/2019 - 12/31/2020 to extend the time period to 6/30/2021 and for additional funds in the amount not-to-exceed \$2,619,463.00; and

WHEREAS, the primary goal of this amendment is to continue to provide career, training and support activities to eligible participants to promote successful employment; and

WHEREAS, the project is funded 100% by Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) funds; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that this Resolution become immediately effective in order that critical services provided by Cuyahoga County can continue and to provide for the usual, daily operation of a County entity.

# NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CUYAHOGA COUNTY, OHIO:

**SECTION 1.** That the Cuyahoga County Council hereby makes an amendment to Contract No. 78 with United Labor Agency Incorporated for operation of the Workforce Service Center, job seekers and employer services and management of the On-the-Job Training Program for the period 7/1/2019 – 12/31/2020 to extend the time

period to 6/30/2021 and for additional funds in the amount not-to-exceed \$2,619,463.00.

**SECTION 2.** That the County Executive is authorized to execute the amendment and all documents consistent with this Resolution.

**SECTION 3.** It is necessary that this Resolution become immediately effective for the usual daily operation of the County; the preservation of public peace, health or safety in the County; and any additional reasons set forth in the preamble. Provided that this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of at least eight members of Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon the earliest occurrence of any of the following: (1) its approval by the County Executive through signature, (2) the expiration of the time during which it may be disapproved by the County Executive under Section 3.10(6) of the Cuyahoga County Charter, or (3) its passage by at least eight members of Council after disapproval pursuant to Section 3.10(7) of the Cuyahoga County Charter. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

**SECTION 4.** It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
