  - a) <u>R2021-0038</u>: A Resolution authorizing an amendment to Contract No.
    78 with The United Labor Agency Incorporated for operation of the Workforce Service Center, job seekers and employer services and

management of the On-the-Job Training Program for the period 7/1/2019 - 12/31/2020 to extend the time period to 6/30/2021 and for additional funds in the amount not-to-exceed \$2,619,463.00; authorizing the County Executive to execute the amendment and all other documents consistent with said award and this Resolution, and declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective.

Mr. Frank Brickner, Interim Executive Director/CEO Cleveland/Cuyahoga County Workforce Development Board; and Mr. Dave Meganhardt, Executive Director of United Labor Agency, addressed the Committee regarding Resolution No. R2021-0038. Discussion ensued.
