1. CALL TO ORDER

Chairwoman Stephens called the meeting to order at 10:01 a.m.

2. ROLL CALL

Ms. Stephens asked Assistant Deputy Clerk Johnson to call the roll. Committee members Stephens, Simon, Gallagher, and Baker were in attendance and a quorum was determined. Committee member Jones entered the meeting after the roll-call was taken. Councilmember Miller was also in attendance.

3. PUBLIC COMMENT

There were no public comments submitted.

4. APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM THE FEBRUARY 18, 2021 MEETING

A motion was made by Ms. Baker, seconded by Mr. Gallagher, and approved by unanimous vote to approve the minutes from the February 18, 2021 meeting.

- 5. MATTERS REFERRED TO COMMITTEE
 - a) R2021-0075: A Resolution authorizing awards totaling \$11,000,000 of U.S. Treasury Emergency Rental Assistance funds to various nonprofit organizations to provide emergency rental assistance to income-eligible

tenants unable to pay their full monthly rent due to the economic impact from COVID-19 for the period 4/1/2021 - 12/31/2021; authorizing the County Executive to execute the agreements and all other documents consistent with said award and this Resolution; and declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective:

- i) CHN Housing Partners in the amount of \$10,000,000
- ii) The Legal Aid Society of Cleveland in the amount of \$1,000,000

Mr. Kahlil Seren, Policy Advisor; Mr. Paul Herdeg, Deputy Chief Economic Development Officer; Mr. Kevin Nowak, Executive Director of CHN Housing Partners; and Ms. Collen Cotter, Executive Director of the Legal Aid Society of Cleveland, addressed the Committee regarding Resolution No. R2021-0075. Discussion ensued.

Committee members and Councilmembers asked questions of Mr. Seren, Mr. Herdeg, Mr. Nowak, and Ms. Cotter pertaining to the item, which they answered accordingly.

On a motion by Ms. Simon with a second by Mr. Jones, Resolution No. R2021-0075 was considered and approved by unanimous vote to be referred to the full Council agenda with a recommendation for passage under second reading suspension of the rules.
