CUYAHOGA COUNTY PUBLIC SAFETY & JUSTICE AFFAIRS COMMITTEE MEETING TUESDAY, JUNE 1, 2021 CUYAHOGA COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE HEADQUARTERS C. ELLEN CONNALLY COUNCIL CHAMBERS – 4TH FLOOR 1:00 PM

1. CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Gallagher called the meeting to order at 1:01 p.m.

2. ROLL CALL

Mr. Gallagher asked Deputy Clerk Carter to call the roll. Committee members Gallagher, Conwell, Tuma, Simon and Miller were in attendance and a quorum was determined. Committee member Jones joined the meeting shortly after the rollcall was taken.

3. PUBLIC COMMENT

There were no public comments submitted.

4. APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM THE MAY 18, 2021 MEETING

A motion was made by Ms. Conwell, seconded by Mr. Tuma and approved by unanimous vote to approve the minutes from the May 18, 2021 meeting.

- 5. MATTERS REFERRED TO COMMITTEE
 - a) <u>R2021-0136</u>: A Resolution authorizing an amendment to Contract No. 871 with Project Management Consultants, LLC for owner's representative services in connection with the Justice Center Complex Project for the period 1/9/2019 - 1/8/2022 to extend the time period to 12/31/2022, to modify the scope of services to include Conceptual Design Phase for the Corrections Center and consulting services to evaluate options for remaining functions at the Justice Center Complex,

effective 6/8/2021, and for additional funds in the amount not-toexceed \$1,270,000.00; authorizing the County Executive to execute the amendment and all other documents consistent with this Resolution; and declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective.

Mr. Michael Dever, Director of the Department of Public Works; and Ms. Nichole English, Planning and Program Administrator, addressed the Committee regarding Resolution No. R2021-0136. Discussion ensued.

Committee members asked questions of Mr. Dever and Ms. English pertaining to the item, which they answered accordingly.

On a motion by Ms. Simon with a second by Mr. Tuma, Resolution No. R2021-0136 was considered and approved by unanimous vote to be referred to the full Council agenda under second reading suspension of the rules.

- b) <u>R2021-0139</u>: A Resolution authorizing an amendment to Contract No. 756 with Applewood Centers, Inc. for secure residential treatment services for the period 1/1/2018 – 6/30/2020 to extend the time period to 6/30/2022, for additional funds in the amount not-to-exceed \$947,099.82 and to modify the terms; authorizing the County Executive to execute the amendment and all other documents consistent with this Resolution; and declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective:
 - to increase the minimum number of beds to be utilized by the Court per day, effective 10/1/2020.
 - 2) to increase the un-used unit rate from \$359.87 per day to \$370.67 per day, effective 7/1/2020 and from \$370.67 per day to \$381.79 per day, effective 7/1/2021.
 - 3) to increase the Medicaid per diem rate from \$359.87 per day to \$370.67 per day, effective 7/1/2020 and from \$370.67 per day to \$381.79 per day, effective 7/1/2021.
 - 4) to add a non-Medicaid per diem rate of \$562.61, effective 7/1/2020 and \$590.94, effective 7/1/2021
 - 5) to add contract language regarding exceptions for the non-acceptance of Court-referred youths, effective 7/1/2020.

Ms. Sarah Baker, Business Manager; and Ms. Bridget Gibbons, Director of Programming; addressed the Committee regarding Resolution No. R2021-0139. Discussion ensued.

Committee members asked questions of Ms. Baker and Ms. Gibbons pertaining to the item, which they answered accordingly.

On a motion by Ms. Conwell with a second by Mr. Gallagher, Resolution No. R2021-0139 was considered and approved by unanimous vote to be referred to the full Council agenda under second reading suspension of the rules.

6. DISCUSSION

a) <u>BC2020-677</u>: Sheriff's Department, requesting authority to prepare an amendment to Agreement No. 348 with City of Bedford Heights for lease of the Bedford Heights Jail, located at 5661 Perkins Road, Bedford Heights for the operation of County jail facilities for the period 10/1/2017 – 9/30/2027, to change the scope of services by assigning full responsibility for transportation, housing, maintenance and general upkeep of the Bedford Heights Jail to the City of Bedford Heights, effective 12/21/2020 and for additional funds in the amount not-to-exceed \$32,000.00.

Mr. Robert Coury, Chief Public Safety and Justice Services Officer; and Mr. Christopher Viland, Sheriff, addressed the Committee regarding BC2020-677. Discussion ensued.

Committee members asked questions of Mr. Coury and Sheriff Viland pertaining to the item, which they answered accordingly.
