1. CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Gallagher called the meeting to order at 1:00 p.m.

2. ROLL CALL

Mr. Gallagher asked Deputy Clerk Carter to call the roll. Committee members Gallagher, Baker, Brady and Conwell were in attendance and a quorum was determined. Committee member Tuma entered the meeting shortly after the roll-call was taken. Councilmember Miller was also in attendance.

3. PUBLIC COMMENT

There were no public comments submitted.

 - a) R2020-0159: A Resolution authorizing a contract with Court Community Service, Inc. in the amount not-to-exceed \$555,000.00 for court community placement and supervision services for probationers referred by the Court in connection with the Community Works Service Placement and Supervision Program for the period 1/1/2021 12/31/2023; authorizing the County Executive to execute the contract

and all other documents consistent with said award and this Resolution; and declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective.

Mr. Martin Murphy, Administrator of the Corrections Planning Board, addressed the Committee regarding Resolution No. R2020-0159. Discussion ensued.

Mr. Coury and Mr. David Schilling, Interim Sheriff, provided the Committee with an update on police officer training with Cuyahoga Community College (Tri-C). Discussion ensued.

WHEREAS, the primary goals of the project are to reduce housing instability and recidivism among reentrants; and

WHEREAS, this project is funded by (a) \$110,000.00 from a Federal Bureau of Justice Assistance Grant and (b) \$490,000.00 from Health and Human Services Levy Funds; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive on behalf of Cuyahoga County Court of Common Pleas/Corrections Planning Board has recommended an amendment to Agreement No. AG1500004-01 with Alcohol, Drug Addiction and Mental Health Services Board of Cuyahoga County for the Adult Probation Substance Abuse Residential Treatment Program for the period 1/1/2015 - 6/30/2020 to extend the time period to 6/30/2022 and for additional funds in the amount not-to-exceed \$1,200,000.00; and
