1. CALL TO ORDER

 - a) R2016-0040: A Resolution making awards on RQ34757 to various providers for staff secure and secure shelter care services for the period 3/1/2016 2/28/2018; authorizing the County Executive to execute the contracts and all other documents consistent with said awards and this Resolution; and declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective:

- 1) Carrington Youth Academy, LLC in the amount not-to-exceed \$2,038,634.00.
- 2) The Cleveland Christian Home Incorporated in the amount not-to-exceed \$588,015.00.
