 - approving a Memorandum of Understanding between Cuyahoga County, the Ohio Patrolmen's Benevolent Association, representing employees in the classification of Correction Officer in the Sheriff's Department, and the International Union, United Automobile, Aerospace and Agricultural Implement Workers of America, Region 2-B, Local 70, representing employees in the classification of Court Security Officer in the Sheriff's Department effective upon

ratification by the Cuyahoga County Council through 04/01/2022, allowing for the use of Court Security Officers to work in the Cuyahoga County Corrections Center when additional corrections staffing is needed.
