CUYAHOGA COUNTY PUBLIC SAFETY & JUSTICE AFFAIRS COMMITTEE MEETING TUESDAY, JUNE 28, 2022 CUYAHOGA COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE HEADQUARTERS C. ELLEN CONNALLY COUNCIL CHAMBERS – 4TH FLOOR 1:00 PM

1. CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Gallagher called the meeting to order at 1:04 p.m.

2. ROLL CALL

Mr. Gallagher asked Deputy Clerk Carter to call the roll. Committee members Gallagher, Conwell, Tuma and Jones were in attendance and a quorum was determined. Committee member Simon was in attendance after the roll-call was taken.

3. PUBLIC COMMENT

There were no public comments given.

4. APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM THE MAY 31, 2022 MEETING

A motion was made by Mr. Tuma, seconded by Ms. Conwell and approved by unanimous vote to approve the minutes from the May 31, 2022 meeting.

- 5. MATTERS REFERRED TO COMMITTEE
 - a) <u>R2022-0173</u>: A Resolution approving a revised Assigned Counsel Fee Schedule for the Cuyahoga County Court of Common Pleas, General and Juvenile Divisions, and the Eighth District Court of Appeals, effective 7/1/2022, and incorporating the 2021 revised Guardian Ad Litem Fee Schedule for the Cuyahoga County Court of Common Pleas, Juvenile

Division; and declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective.

The Honorable Brendan J. Sheehan, Administrative and Presiding Judge of Common Pleas Court; The Honorable Sean C. Gallagher, Administrative Judge of the Eighth District Court of Appeals; The Honorable Thomas F. O'Malley, Administrative Judge of Juvenile Court; Mr. Mark Stanton, Esq.; Mr. Thomas Shaughnessy, Esq., representing the Cuyahoga Criminal Defense Lawyers Association; and Mr. Gregory Popovich, Administrator of Common Pleas Court, addressed the Committee regarding Resolution No. R2022-0173. Discussion ensued.

Committee members asked questions of Judge Sheehan, Judge Gallagher, Judge O'Malley, Mr. Stanton, Mr. Shaughnessy and Mr. Popovich pertaining to the item, which they answered accordingly.

b) <u>R2022-0189</u>: A Resolution authorizing a revenue generating agreement with City of Cleveland/Cleveland Municipal Court in the amount not-toexceed \$2,349,218.00 for legal services for indigent persons for the period 1/1/2022 - 12/31/2022; authorizing the County Executive to execute Agreement No. 2523 and all other documents consistent with this Resolution; and declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective.

Mr. Cullen Sweeney, Chief Public Defender, addressed the Committee regarding Resolution No. R2022-0189. Discussion ensued.

Committee members asked questions of Mr. Sweeney pertaining to the item, which he answered accordingly.

On a motion by Ms. Simon with a second by Mr. Tuma, Resolution No. R2022-0189 was considered and approved by unanimous vote to be referred to the full Council agenda with a recommendation for passage under second reading suspension of the rules.
