 - a) R2022-0043: A Resolution making an award on RQ8257 to C.A.

 Agresta Construction Company in the amount not-to-exceed

 \$1,187,894.40 for resurfacing of Green Road from Miles Road to
 Emery Road in the City of Warrensville Heights in connection with the

2021 – 2024 Transportation Improvement Program; authorizing the County Executive to execute Contract No. 2221 and all other documents consistent with said award and this Resolution; and declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective.
