## 1. CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Tuma called the meeting to order at 10:05 a.m.
2. ROLL CALL

Mr. Tuma asked Deputy Clerk Carter to call the roll. Committee members Tuma, Miller, Conwell, Sweeney and Turner were in attendance and a quorum was determined.

## 3. PUBLIC COMMENT

There were no public comments given.
4. APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM THE JUNE 15, 2022 MEETING

A motion was made by Ms. Turner, seconded by Mr. Sweeney and approved by unanimous vote to approve the minutes from the June 15, 2022 meeting.
5. MATTERS REFERRED TO COMMITTEE
a) R2022-0154: A Resolution awarding a total sum, not to exceed $\$ 1,145,644.92$, to the City of Parma Heights for the purpose of constructing the Nathan Hale Stormwater Basin from the District 4 ARPA Community Grant Fund; and declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective.

The Honorable Marie Gallo, Mayor of the City of Parma Heights; Mr. Dan Bender, City Engineer for the City of Parma Heights; and Mr. Joseph Sebes, City Services Coordinator for the City of Parma Heights, addressed the Committee regarding Resolution No. R2022-0154. Discussion ensued.

Committee members asked questions of Mayor Gallo, Mr. Bender and Mr. Sebes pertaining to the item, which they answered accordingly.

On a motion by Mr. Tuma with a second by Mr. Sweeney, Resolution No. R20220154 was considered and approved by unanimous vote to be referred to the full Council agenda for second reading.
b) R2022-0183: A Resolution declaring that public convenience and welfare requires construction of East $26^{\text {th }}$ Street from Community College Avenue to Central Avenue in the City of Cleveland; total estimated project cost $\$ 2,000,000.00$; finding that special assessments will neither be levied nor collected to pay for any part of the County's costs of said improvement; authorizing the County Executive to enter into an agreement of cooperation with said municipalities in connection with said project; and declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective.

Ms. Nichole English, Planning and Program Administrator, addressed the Committee regarding Resolution No. R2022-0183. Discussion ensued.

Committee members asked questions of Ms. English pertaining to the item, which she answered accordingly.

On a motion by Mr. Tuma with a second by Ms. Conwell, Resolution No. R20220183 was considered and approved by unanimous vote to be referred to the full Council agenda for second reading.

Committee members Conwell and Turner requested to have their names added as co-sponsors to Resolution No. R2022-0183.
c) R2022-0184: A Resolution making an award on RQ9273 to Chagrin Valley Paving Incorporated in the amount not-to-exceed \$524,707.50 for reconstruction of Cuyahoga County Airport South taxi lanes U and V; authorizing the County Executive to execute Contract No. 2511 and all other documents consistent with said award and this Resolution; and this Resolution and declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective.

Ms. English addressed the Committee regarding Resolution No. R2022-0184. Discussion ensued.

Committee members asked questions of Ms. English pertaining to the item, which she answered accordingly.

On a motion by Mr. Tuma with a second by Mr. Miller, Resolution No. R2022-0184 was considered and approved by unanimous vote to be referred to the full Council agenda with a recommendation for passage under second reading suspension of the rules.
