1. CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Gallagher called the meeting to order at 1:01 p.m.

2. ROLL CALL

Mr. Gallagher asked Deputy Clerk Carter to call the roll. Committee members Gallagher, Conwell, Tuma and Jones were in attendance and a quorum was determined. Committee member Simon entered the meeting after the roll call was taken.

3. PUBLIC COMMENT

There were no public comments given.

4. APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM THE OCTOBER 18, 2022 MEETING

A motion was made by Ms. Conwell, seconded by Mr. Tuma and approved by unanimous vote to approve the minutes from the October 18, 2022 meeting.

5. MATTERS REFERRED TO COMMITTEE

a) R2022-0386: A Resolution authorizing an amendment to Agreement No. 1622 with Chagrin Valley Dispatch Council for dispatch operation services for law enforcement activities for the period 4/28/2021 – 12/31/2022 to extend the time period to 12/31/2024 and for additional funds in the amount not-to-exceed \$1,944,501.71; authorizing the County Executive to execute the Agreement and all other documents

consistent with this Resolution; and declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective.

Mr. Chris Costin, Business Administrator; Sgt. Padraig Devlin, Deputy Sheriff; and Mr. Dan Grimes, Director of IT Operations for Chagrin Valley Dispatch Council, addressed the Committee regarding Resolution No. R2022-0386. Discussion ensued.

Committee members asked questions of Mr. Costin, Sgt. Devlin & Mr. Grimes pertaining to the item, which they answered accordingly.

On a motion by Mr. Gallagher with a second by Mr. Tuma, Resolution No. R2022-0386 was considered and approved by unanimous vote to be referred to the full Council agenda with a recommendation for passage under second reading suspension of the rules.

b) R2022-0387: A Resolution making an award on RQ9001 for a Membership Participation Agreement with Chagrin Valley Dispatch Council in the amount not-to-exceed \$4,419,735.32 for the purchase of handheld portable radios and accessories for various officers of the Sheriff's Department and Juvenile Justice Center for the period 1/1/2023 – 12/31/2027; authorizing the County Executive to execute the Agreement No. 2794 and all other documents consistent with said award and this Resolution; and declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective.

Mr. Steven Hammett, Interim Sheriff; and Sgt. Devlin, addressed the Committee regarding Resolution No. R2022-0387. Discussion ensued.

Committee members asked questions of Sheriff Hammett and Sgt. Devlin pertaining to the item, which they answered accordingly.

On a motion by Mr. Tuma with a second by Mr. Jones, Resolution No. R2022-0387 was considered and approved by unanimous vote to be referred to the full Council agenda with a recommendation for passage under second reading suspension of the rules.

c) R2022-0388: A Resolution authorizing an amendment to Contract No. 1703 (fka Contract No. 472) with Alcohol, Drug Addiction and Mental Health Services Board for the Mental Health and Substance Abuse/Addiction Diversion Center for the period 12/8/2020 – 12/31/2022, to extend the time period to 12/31/2023, to expand the scope of services, effective upon contract signature of all parties, and for additional funds in the amount not to-to-exceed \$4,363,012.00.

Ms. Brandy Carney, Director of Public Safety & Justice Services, addressed the Committee regarding Resolution No. R2022-0388. Discussion ensued.

Committee members asked questions of Ms. Carney pertaining to the item, which she answered accordingly.

On a motion by Ms. Simon with a second by Mr. Tuma, Resolution No. R2022-0388 was considered and approved by unanimous vote to be referred to the full Council agenda with a recommendation for passage under second reading suspension of the rules.

6. MISCELLANEOUS BUSINESS

There was no miscellaneous business.
