## CUYAHOGA COUNTY EDUCATION, ENVIRONMENT & SUSTAINABILITY COMMITTEE MEETING WEDNESDAY, APRIL 5, 2023 CUYAHOGA COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE HEADQUARTERS C. ELLEN CONNALLY COUNCIL CHAMBERS – 4<sup>TH</sup> FLOOR 3:00 PM

1. CALL TO ORDER

Chairwoman Simon called the meeting to order at 3:17 p.m.

2. ROLL CALL

Ms. Simon asked Assistant Deputy Clerk Georgakopoulos to call the roll. Committee members Simon, Stephens and Jones were in attendance and a quorum was determined. Committee member Schron was in attendance after the roll call was taken. Committee member Conwell was absent from the meeting.

3. PUBLIC COMMENT

There were no public comments given.

4. APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM THE MARCH 8, 2023 MEETING

A motion was made by Ms. Stephens, seconded by Mr. Jones and approved by unanimous vote to approve the minutes from the March 8, 2023 meeting.

- 5. MATTERS REFERRED TO COMMITTEE
  - a) <u>R2023-0067</u>: A Resolution awarding a total sum, not to exceed \$250,000, to the Village of Chagrin Falls for Wastewater Treatment Plant Improvements – Phase 2, from the District 6 ARPA Community Grant Fund; and declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective.

The Honorable William A. Tomko, Mayor and Mr. Robert Jamieson, Chief Administrative Officer for the Village of Chagrin Falls; and Ms. Georgia Conway, Project Engineer for CT Consultants, addressed the Committee regarding Resolution No. R2023-0067. Discussion ensued.

Committee members asked questions of Mayor Tomko, Mr. Jamieson and Ms. Conway pertaining to the item, which they answered accordingly.

On a motion by Ms. Simon with a second by Mr. Schron, Resolution No. R2023-0067 was considered and approved by unanimous vote to be referred to the full Council agenda for second reading.

Ms. Simon and Mr. Jones requested to have their names added as co-sponsors to the legislation.

b) <u>R2023-0077</u>: A Resolution making an award to College Now Greater Cleveland in the amount of \$500,000.00 from the Cuyahoga County Educational Assistance Fund for Component Two of the Cuyahoga County Educational Assistance Program for the period ending 6/30/2027; and declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective.

Ms. Kittie Warshawsky, Chief External Affairs Officer and Mr. Robert Durham, Chief Scholarship Services Officer from College Now Greater Cleveland, addressed the Committee regarding Resolution No. R2023-0077. Discussion ensued.

Committee members asked questions of Ms. Warshawsky and Mr. Durham pertaining to the item, which they answered accordingly.

On a motion by Ms. Simon with a second by Ms. Stephens, Resolution No. R2023-0077 was considered and approved by unanimous vote to be referred to the full Council agenda for second reading.

Ms. Simon requested to have her name added as a co-sponsor to the legislation.

c) <u>R2023-0083</u>: A Resolution authorizing an amendment to Contract No. 78 with United Labor Agency Incorporated for operation of the Workforce Service Center, job seekers and employer services and management of the On-the-Job Training Program and the Federal Reemployment Services and Reemployment Services and Eligibility Assessment (RESEA) program for the period 7/1/2019 – 6/30/2023 for additional funds in the amount not-to-exceed \$2,509,779.50; authorizing the County Executive to execute the amendment and all other documents consistent with this Resolution; and declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective.

Ms. Laura Chalker, Deputy Director of Ohio Means Jobs Cleveland-Cuyahoga County, addressed the Committee regarding Resolution No. R2023-0083. Discussion ensued.

Committee members asked questions of Ms. Chalker pertaining to the item, which she answered accordingly.

On a motion by Ms. Simon with a second by Mr. Schron, Resolution No. R2023-0083 was considered and approved by unanimous vote to be referred to the full Council agenda with a recommendation for passage under second reading suspension of the rules.

> d) <u>R2023-0084</u>: A Resolution authorizing an amendment to a Memorandum of Understanding and Agreement among various parties concerning Say Yes Cleveland for the period 7/24/2019 – 7/23/2023 to amend prior listed aggregate amounts in the Memorandum of Understanding and for additional funds in the amount not-to-exceed \$2,100,000.00; authorizing the County Executive to execute the amendment to the Memorandum of Understanding and all other documents consistent with this Resolution; and declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective.

Mr. David Merriman, Director of the Department of Health and Human Services; Mr. Matt Carroll, Chief Economic Growth and Opportunity Officer for the Executive's Office; and Ms. Diane Downing, Executive Director of Say Yes Cleveland, addressed the Committee regarding Resolution No. R2023-0084. Discussion ensued.

Committee members asked questions of Mr. Merriman, Mr. Carroll and Ms. Downing pertaining to the item, which they answered accordingly.

On a motion by Ms. Simon with a second by Mr. Jones, Resolution No. R2023-0084 was considered and approved by unanimous vote to be referred to the full Council agenda for second reading.
