  - a) R2023-0066: A Resolution awarding a total sum, not to exceed \$250,000, to the Village of Glenwillow for the Cochran Road Phase 2 Reconstruction Project from the District 6 ARPA Community Grant Fund; and declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective.

The Honorable Mark Cegelka, Mayor of the Village of Glenwillow and Mr. Ed Hren, Vice President of Chagrin Valley Engineering, Ltd., addressed the Committee regarding Resolution No. R2023-0066. Discussion ensued.

Committee members asked questions of Mayor Cegelka and Mr. Hren pertaining to the item, which they answered accordingly.

**WHEREAS**, the County Executive/Department of Public Works/Division of County Engineer recommends that public convenience and welfare requires the replacement of Ridgewood Drive Bridge No. 03.50 over West Creek in the City of Parma; and

WHEREAS, the anticipated start date is 2026; and

**WHEREAS**, that special assessments will neither be levied nor collected to pay for any part of the County's costs of said improvement; and
