c) <u>R2023-0160</u>: A Resolution authorizing an amendment to Contract No. 3345 (fka Contract No. 78) with United Labor Agency Incorporated for operation of the Workforce Service Center, job seekers and employer services and management of the On-the-Job Training Program and the Federal Reemployment Services and Reemployment Services Eligibility Assessment (RESEA) program for the period 7/1/2019 – 6/30/2023 to extend the time period to 6/30/2024 and for additional funds in the amount not-to-exceed \$4,138,362.31; and declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective.
